Terms and conditions of participation

Selection

- Participation is only open to <u>judges, prosecutors and other</u> members of the <u>judiciary from an EU Member State, EEA/EFTA</u> country or EU candidate country.
- 2. The number of places available is limited. Participation will be subject to a selection procedure. Selection will be dependent on:
 - i. the relevance of the seminars to the professional life of the applicant;
 - ii. the ability to disseminate what they have learnt;
 - iii. geographical and linguistic balance among the participants will also be sought;
 - iv. priority will be given to applicants who have not already participated in one of the earlier editions of this event;
 - v. only one person per institution may be accepted.
- 3. Applications can be made until 14 October 2013.
- 4. A response will be given to every applicant of this seminar shortly after this deadline. We advise you not to book any travel or hotel before you receive our confirmation.

Registration Fee

5. There is no registration fee.

Travel expenses
