Subject: Invitation to participate in the Group of Experts advising on judicial online training

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

The European Commission's Directorate General of Justice and Consumers (DG JUST) has launched a project for the development of 40 training e-Capsules on EU law, which will be undertaken by a partnership between ICF and the European Institute of Public Administration (EIPA). This project is an important tool in the implementation of the European judicial training strategy 2021-2024 ([Commission Communication 'Ensuring justice in the EU — a European judicial training strategy for 2021-2024'](#)).
