

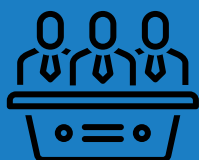
PROJECT-BASED EXCHANGES

ABOUT

In a project-based exchange, judges, prosecutors or court & prosecution staff, individually or in a group **from the same or different** court or prosecution office, exchange experiences and best practices on a specific topic of common interest with their counterparts in a court or prosecution office in another EU Member State.

An exchange lasts **between 2 and 5 days** with a visiting delegation of **1 to 5 judges, prosecutors or court & prosecution staff**.

EXAMPLE



Prosecutors from Czechia frequently work on cases involving co-operation with Lithuanian authorities. A prosecution office therefore wants to obtain more information about the Lithuanian crime prevention and prosecution system. A delegation of up to 5 prosecutors travel to Vilnius to exchange with their colleagues.



Two Italian court staff and two Slovenian judges can take part in a three-day exchange in Romania, for instance focusing on artificial intelligence and human rights.



Who

Judges, prosecutors, and court & prosecution staff of one or different court or prosecution office visit the court or prosecution office in another Member State.



Where

Applying courts or prosecution offices must have an established contact and provide a hosting agreement in advance. Exchanges can take place in all Member States except Denmark.



When

The call for applications is published between September and mid-October for an exchange in the coming year.

APPLICATIONS

Any application must be submitted on the Exchange Programme Platform and include:

- A **project proposal form**, detailing the topics that will be tackled during the exchange;
- A **hosting agreement**, signed by the host institution.
- A **draft agenda**, using EJTN's template
